Assessment criteria

Butterfield will assess all applications to the following criteria:

STRATEGIC Activities that are based on a strategy with both short and long-term objectives, focusing on a few key areas for greatest

impact.

ALIGNED The request aligns with Butterfield's sustainability strategy and priority Sustainable Development Goals, as well as with the

development priorities of local communities, the non-profit sector, and government.

SUSTAINABLE The request: (i) seeks to avoid dependency on short-term funding, (ii) creates long-term benefits, and; the project/

programme will be sustained at the end of the funding period.

MEASURABLE There is a significant need for the funding (ideally based on evidence) and the return on community investment can be

measured in terms of outcomes and impact.

OPERATIONAL Requested and submitted documents conform to Bermuda laws, the latest financial accounts show a solvent position, are

produced on a timely basis in accordance with the relevant Financial Reporting Standard and are independently verified.

Applications will be reviewed quarterly. You will be notified if your application is successful or not.
